



Lutronic Corp Reports Record Q2 Results. Establishes U.S. R&D Center.

15% Revenue Growth and 30% Increase in Profit for Comparable Period of 2009

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Lutronic Corp (KOSDAQ) commenced the month by announcing second-quarter financial results for the three month period, ending June 30, 2010.

Revenues for the second quarter of 2010 improved to \$11.5 million as compared to \$10 million, at a comparable exchange rate, for Q2 of 2009, reflecting an increase of 15%. Profit exceeded 30% above that of 2009 Q2.

According to Haelyung Hwang, CEO of Lutronic Corp, "In an era when many of the aesthetic device manufacturers are struggling, Lutronic has experienced remarkable growth in the world-wide acceptance of our best-in-class products. The 1444nm AccuSculpt™ device is becoming the standard for laser assisted facial contouring, better known as the AccuLift™ procedure. We continue to be the dominant leader in q-switched Nd: YAG devices with Spectra sales remaining strong. Our fractional devices MOSAIC™ and eCO2™ continue to perform well. "
